

STANFORD DINGLEY BUSINESS & ENTERTAINMENT HUB LOCATED IN THE VILLAGE HALL

Over the past 12 months the Stanford Dingley Village Hall has been updated to provide local business communities with modern state of the art facilities for budding entrepreneurs, start ups and SME companies. It is a place where they can access super fast fibre optic broadband, have dedicated hot desks and state of the art audio visual, printing and laminating facilities.

It means that people can come together to share ideas and expertise, set up conferencing with other remote workers, have business meetings and run training events. The kitchen is fully equipped and will provide tea, coffee and soft drinks as well as cooking facilities.

What exactly does it have?

A flexible 36 sq m meeting space (6.6m by 5.4m) to accommodate up to 50 people networking space or as a saleroom for arts and crafts, 35-40 people seated theatre style, 20 people either in house training or access to external training media via broadband and up to 6 Hot Desks for individuals to work.

- In addition there is room for 10 people to engage in physical activities such as Yoga, Pilates, Tai-Chi.
- A fully equipped kitchen and servery with hob, oven, fridge, sink, extractor hood, cutlery, crockery and glassware.
- Unisex disabled toilet with baby change facility.
- Dimmable LED lighting system.
- Large drop-down screen, 3D projector with HDMI, laptop connectivity and projection, AV receiver, CD / DVD / Blu-ray player and built-in hi-fi surround sound system with Blu-tooth playback from mobile devices.
- WiFi enabled up to 900Mbps fibre broadband.
- A round-the-hall picture rail for art exhibitions and other rural crafts.
- Full colour printing via laptop or mobile devices and laminating.
- Flipcharts and Whiteboard for mind mapping and brain storming.

Business Meetings

If you and your colleagues need to get away from the phones and constant interruptions to have some peace and quiet for more contemplative activities such as strategic planning or board meetings? Or perhaps your club, society or charity needs a more formal setting for an AGM or a Trustees meeting Stanford Dingley Village Hall could be the ideal venue. The hi-spec AV system will meet most presentation and training needs and for those who need to stay connected we have a 900Mbs broadband fibre connection.

Catering options range from self service tea and coffee from the kitchen to a fully catered service from one of our two pub / restaurants, The Old Boot Inn (about 50 metres from the hall) and the Bull Inn (200 metres from the hall) who can support events either with onsite catering or offering lunch in their dining rooms.

Exhibitions, Shows and Sales

If you want to set up an exhibition the hall has an abundance of natural light and also benefits from adjustable spotlights on tracks either side of the hall. We have easily configurable tables on which to exhibit items and all round the hall there is a traditional picture rail from which to hang your work.

Talks, Lectures and Conferences

With space and chairs to seat 40-45 people in a lecture style layout, a hi-res projector, large drop-down screen and laptop / tablet input, the hall is very capable of handling small to medium size gatherings for talks, lectures and society / club meetings. If you wish to serve cups of tea or a glass of wine to your guests, the kitchen / servery and the hall's stock of crockery and glassware make such occasions very straightforward.

Location

Stanford Dingley is the smallest parish in West Berkshire with around just 80 households. Much of the village is a conservation area and sits in the Pang Valley, part of the North Wessex Downs area of outstanding natural beauty. With the River Pang chalk stream flowing gently through the centre of the village, it is a tranquil, unspoilt rural location that offers respite from the modern, fast-paced, pressured lifestyles most of us lead.

Parking

Stanford Dingley Village Hall is located on a very small country lane and parking options include:

1. For Villagers, people should walk and less mobile visitors can be dropped off but there are a maximum of two parking spaces on the lane outside the hall.
2. For local communities, parking at The Old Boot Inn by prior arrangement with the Landlord, Mr Andre Claassen 0118 9744292 or Rebecca 07599 664119.
3. For corporations, larger scale off road parking in paddocks or fields close to the hall and subject to weather can be arranged at the time of booking the hall.
