

Village Survey Top Line Results

- 28 responses covering 82 villagers or approximately half of the population of the village / albeit only just over 1/3 of the households
- Evenly spread demographically and North and South sides of the village
- Showed a mix of views and priorities with a few clear priorities coming through and some clear non-priorities too.
- Summary responses on key topics are here but the full survey responses can be made available.


Headline / Summary Unprompted Responses

- What do you enjoy most about village life Every single respondent mentioned either
 - a) The sense of community or
 - b) Peace and Quiet and Access to countryside.
- What concerns you most about village life?
 - Speeding in the village
 - Overdevelopment
 - Closely followed by Lack of facilities for children and noise from other sources aircraft, pubs, clay pigeon, bird scarers

Prompted Responses – 75% say the Pubs are a Really Important resource for the village

On a scale of 1 - 5 (1 - not important - 5 - really important) please say how important to you and your family access to pubs in the village is.


28 responses

- The clubroom and the church did not fare so well with less than 25% or 33% rating them really or even somewhat important as resources.

But the most important resource isn't even in the village


On a scale of 1 - 5 (1 - not important - 5 - really important) please say how important to you and your family access to the countryside/ public footpaths is ^{28 responses}




Social Events – 68% of respondents said social events were Really Important

On a scale of 1 - 5 (1 - not important - 5 - really important) please say how important to you and your family access to social events in the village are 28 responses




Will you help?

Support - (with regular time commitments) 28 responses




Will you lead an event?

The challenges we face...


• State of the Roads is the number one concern with 75% rating it as an issue or serious issue. Traffic/speeding next at 65%

• State of footpaths – 57%. Flooding 21 % and housing mix - 27%

 However 'overdevelopment' was also cited as a key concern for almost all respondents – we just don't have a percentage number.
